1. On a separate piece of paper, choose and answer three (3) of the following questions in complete sentences. **Minimum of 5 sentences**
2. **Choose one quote, cite it, and respond to it in a paragraph** – why is it important? What symbol/theme does it relate to? Why/How? **(at least 5 sentences)**
  1. What is the irony of what arrives on the island in the opening pages of this chapter (6) and Ralph’s wish at the end of Chapter 5?
  2. How does the narrator’s description differ from Samneric’s description of the Beast? Why do these descriptions differ? **BE SPECIFIC!!**
  3. Explain this quote, remember, Simon hasn’t seen the beast on the mountain: “However Simon thought of the beast, there rose before his inward sight the picture of a human at once heroic and sick.” (Golding 103) Why would Simon have this in his mind as the beast? Remember what his thought was for what the beast might be in Chapter 5.
  4. Explain this quote: “Something deep in Ralph spoke for him” (Golding 104)
  5. In this chapter Ralph points to something that is all they have. Compare this to what he has said is all they have in Chapter 5 and discuss why it might not be this way anymore.
  6. Explain this quote: “ ‘I’m chief. We’ve got to make certain. Can’t you see the mountain? There’s no signal showing. There may be a ship out there. Are you all off your rockers?’ Mutinously, the boys fell silent or muttering. Jack led the way down the rock and across the bridge” (Golding 108)
